The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.85, dated 17.04.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379-B and 506 IPC and Section 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act (Section 325 IPC added later on), at Police Station Nigdhu, Karnal.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Tinku. The incident was occurred on 10.04.2021 at 8.00 pm. It is alleged that 3-4 youths came and gave slaps and snatched Rs.2370/- alongwith mobile phone. The allegations against the petitioner are that he abused the first informant by his caste.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the first

informant has already given an affidavit to the police with the assertion that

the petitioner is not involved. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 02.05.2021.

Mr. Ankur Mittal, Addl. AG, Haryana, submits that the police has already completed the investigation, however, final report is yet to be filed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the present case and delay of 7 days in registration of the FIR, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
