The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to finalize the pension case of the petitioner and release the entire payments of his pensionary benefits consisting of pension, commuted pension, gratuity and full payment of leave encashment etc. after deciding the charge-sheet dated 01.01.2020 issued to the petitioner after his retirement alongwith

interest @ 12% per annum for which **“Notice of Demand”** dated 21.04.2021 (Annexure P-2) has also been served by the petitioner.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the **“Notice of Demand”** dated 21.04.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
