The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58, dated 04.06.2020, registered under Section 498-A of IPC (Section 306 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Mulepur District Fatehgarh Sahib.

By an order dated 09.02.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed her to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the matter has been settled amicably and the petition for quashing of FIR has been filed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh, submits that petitioner has joined investigation.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 09.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
