This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks a *mandamus* directing the 3rd respondent i.e. Tehsildar, Panipat to register the property in question in the name of the person to whom the petitioner wishes to sell the same.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 06.07.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Pursuant to the order dated 28.05.2021 passed by this Court, Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, Addl. A.G. Haryana, contends that the matter is still under consideration and now a legal opinion in the matter has been sought.

Per contra counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon an order dated 14.06.2021 passed by the Director, Town & Country Planning, Haryana, Chandigarh and a copy of which has been forwarded to this Court by way of email to contend that inspite of clear cut directions issued therein, Tehsildar Panipat i.e. the 3rd respondent is declining to register the property of the petitioner in the name of the person to which the petitioner wishes to sell the same.

Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, Addl. A.G. Haryana, is directed to file a response to the petition within a period of two weeks.

During the course of hearing today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the process of registration has commenced and he has instructions from the petitioner not to pursue the instant petition.

Petition is disposed of as not pressed.
