Petitioners-Jagtar Singh and 46 others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take into consideration the higher marks secured by the petitioners in 10+2 examination.

Records of the case show that when this case came up for hearing on 27.05.2021, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that similar writ petition i.e. CWP-22985-2016 is fixed for final arguments. Accordingly, the case was adjourned to 20.07.2021.

Today, CM-7244-2021 has been listed on behalf of the petitioners *inter alia* with a prayer to pass the same orders in the present

petition as in CWP-22985-2016.

CM-8222-2021 has been filed *inter alia* with a prayer to withdraw the present writ petition. In this application, it has been inter alia pleaded that CWP-22985-2016 has been dismissed on 05.07.2021.

In view of the above, on the oral request made by counsel for the petitioners, main case is taken up on board today itself i.e. 15.07.2021.

Accordingly, CM-8222-2021 is allowed. Main writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the order passed in CM-8222-2021, no separate orders are called for in CM-7244-2021 and the same stands disposed of accordingly.
