SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate direction to official respondents No. 2 and 3 for protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the respondent No.4.

In response to the notice issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit dated 23.07.2020 has been filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3., wherein it has been deposed as under:-

“1. That the petitioners have no cause of action to invoke the extra ordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. As neither petitioners are required by the police in connection with any case nor they were ever been called by the answering respondent or respondent No.4 as alleged by the petitioners. Moreover, there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, petitioners have filed the present petition before this Court, only with intention to pressurize the police department and create evidence in favour of their close relative namely Sonu Bhatti.

2. That brief facts of this case are that a case bearing FIR No.192 dated 18.06.2020 U/s 307/452/506/148/149 IPC and 25/27 Arms Act Police Station City Ferozepur has been registered against said Sonu Bhatti and Mithu Sahota, Akash son of Kewal, Shankr son of Tamba, Samual @ Soma, Ladha and Jyoti on the basis of statement of Jagga Sahota son of Hayata Sahota resident of Old Vegetable Market, Bagdadi Gate, Ferozepur City with the allegations that on 17.06.2020 at about 8.45 PM when he was standing in front of his house then accused came there. On raising lalkara by Mithu Sahota, said Sonu Bhatti fired shot with his pistol towards complainant with intention to kill him, but

complainant succeeded to save himself by immediately entered into his own house. Then Mithu Sahota fired shot with intention to kill the complainant which hit on the door of Sadhu. Complainant with intention to save himself went to roof of his house, then all the accused persons entered into the house of complainant and fired shots. On hearing the shout many people gathered there due to which all the accused run away from the spot. After registration of the case, police party is conducting the raids to every places where the possibility of presence of Sonu Bhatti is there, now petitioners who are close relatives of said Sonu Bhatti had filed the present petition on false and baseless grounds create evidence in favour of their close relative namely Sonu Bhatti.”

In view of the above, no order is called for.

Petition is disposed of.
