Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.126 dated 22.05.2021 under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC (Section 120-B IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Parmila, two young boys came to her house and took her on the pretext that her mother got injured. Thereafter, when she returned back home and came out, those boys caused injuries to her. It is further submitted that only simple injuries have been inflicted to the complainant and the petitioner is involved in this case on account of rivalry between the families. It is also submitted that in pursuance of the order dated

01.06.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Parveen Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.06.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
