This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 28.08.2020 under Sections 454 and 380 of the IPC registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner prays that a lenient and compassionate view be taken qua the petitioner. He submits that not only is the petitioner an illiterate man, but even his mother, whose affidavit was annexed along with the bail application under Section 437 CrPC filed before the trial Court, is an illiterate woman

and whatever she did, she did so in good faith and on the asking of his counsel. Learned counsel thus prays that in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

I have heard the learned counsel and perused the material on record, along with the report received from the trial Court concerned.

Admittedly, the petitioner was behind bars and it was his mother, an illiterate woman, who signed in good faith all the documents including the affidavit which were given to her by his counsel.

In the aforementioned facts and circumstances and the unqualified apology which has been tendered by the petitioner through his counsel, the same is accepted. The prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner to withdraw the instant petition is accepted.

Ordered accordingly.
