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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

The petitioners have filed this petition by way of Public Interest Litigation alleging that the respondent-authorities have permitted the activities which are resulting in pollution etc. in Sector 50-C, Chandigarh by unidentified people who are dumping garbage right opposite to the residential societies of the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing for the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh on instructions from Mr. Ashwani Kumar, Area Sanitary Inspector, submits that all such activities have been stopped and the site in question has been cleared and the authorities are taking necessary steps by conducting regular checking at the site and have also taken measures to see that such polluting activities are not taken up again at the place concerned.

In view of the aforesaid statement of the learned counsel appearing for Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, no further order is required to be passed by this Court in the present petition which is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent-authorities in case further occasion arises for the same.
