Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.180 dated 16.04.2021 under Sections 15 & 25 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of ASI Sharif Khan, when he was on patrol duty along with co-officials, he received a secret information that Gursewak Singh (petitioner) along with some other persons has formed a gang for bringing poppy husk from the other States and for selling in Barnala. They are coming in Bolero Camper bearing registration No.PB-29-N-9646 and can be

apprehended. On receiving such information, a ruqa was sent to the police station for registration of the FIR and for sending second Investigating Officer. Thereafter, ASI Satwinder Pal Singh put a barrier and apprehended the petitioner and from Bolero Camper, which was found in possession, 08 bags of poppy husk containing 20 kg each were recovered. In the meantime, two co-accused Pritpal Singh and Pinky Kaur, who were also in the said vehicle, fled away from the spot by taking benefit of the darkness and their names were disclosed by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 20.07.2021 in the Court today. As per this custody certificate, the petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months. It is submitted that FSL report is received and challan will be presented in due time.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that recovery of commercial quantity of poppy husk was effected from the petitioner, I find no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
