The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to grant the family pension as the petitioner (40% handicapped) is fully dependent on his father (deceased employee) with all consequences for which representation dated 13.02.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been moved by the petitioner.
