The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this transfer application, Jaspreet Kaur (wife) seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/5/2021, titled as 'Gurpreet Singh vs. Jaspreet Kaur' pending in the Court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Sangrur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

The petitioner claims that at present she is residing with her aged parents at Village Noorpura, Tehsil Patran, District Patiala and cannot travel alone to Sangrur.

Sh. Gaurav Sharma, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent and has stated that the petitioner is resident of Village Noorpura, Tehsil Patran, District Patiala, which is at a distance of 53 kms from District Sangrur whereas the distance between Village Noorpura and District Court Patiala is 68 kms. Since the proceedings are pending at Sangrur, which is nearer to the place of residence of the

petitioner as compared to the place, where she wants to case to be transferred, hence, no ground to transfer is made out.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.
