The affidavit dated 02.09.2021 of the petitioner-Priyanka Kanda is taken on the record.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to take legal action against the respondents on the basis of a complaint dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a complaint/representation, dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, District Moga i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, District Moga, to take a decision on the representation dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
