Present application has been filed under Section 482
Cr.P.C. for correction in para No.2 of the petitioner bearing CRWP
No. 4435 of 2020.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same
allowed and the date of incidents and releasing date be treated as
11.05.2020 and 12.05.2020 respectively in para No.2 of the writ
petition instead of 11.06.2020 and 12.06.2020.

CRWP-4435 of 2020(O&M)

Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article
226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of
mandamus directing respondent No. 2 to take into consideration the
representation (Annexure P-3) and further to protect the life and
liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 3 and 4 and
to further direct respondents No. 1 to 4 to compensate the petitioners
for such atrocious acts committed by respondents No. 3 and 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 for taking a decision on the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to take appropriate steps as may be required in accordance with law.
