Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 20.05.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 452 & 506 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sector 13-17, Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been attributed any injury. She is a 32 year old lady and is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 01.06.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has filed reply of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime Against Women, Panipat. He, upon instructions, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
