1. At the outset, learned State counsel has referred to the reply filed in connected CWP-10594-2019. Relevant extract of the same is reproduced as under:-

“xx xx xx

In view of above instructions, matter has been examined and it has been found that only two posts of SI (Male) in general category are vacant against which two senior most candidates (as per order of merit conveyed by HSSC) i.e. Ajay Kumar (petitioner in CWP-9875-2019 and Sunit Kumar Petitioner in CWP No.11643-2019), can be given appointment.

xx xx xx”

2. Learned State counsel states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been accepted, the petitioner would be issued appointment letter by the competent authority within one week from today.

3. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the writ petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to move a representation before the competent authority for grant of seniority as per his merit ranking and the competent authority being directed to decide the same in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

4. The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel.

5. In view of the position noted above, the writ petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders except directing respondent No.2 to adhere to the assurance held out by the learned State counsel on the basis of affidavit dated 14.12.2021, filed by Mr. Sanjay Kumar, IPS, Inspector General of Police, Administration PHQ, Haryana, Panchkula, and to issue appointment letter to the petitioner within one week from today. Needless to mention, in case any representation is filed by the petitioner within ten days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order for grant of seniority and consequential benefits as per his merit ranking, the competent authority is directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within three months from the date of receipt of representation.
