The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 88, dated 28.07.2018, under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station City-II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

The FIR in question is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the parties as urged by learned counsel for the petitioner. The matter was, therefore, referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, wherein, the parties arrived at an amicable settlement.

Report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, which is placed in the case file also substantiates the aforesaid fact.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 30th July, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jaspal Singh, states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30th July, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
