HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J (ORAL)

In the present case, the petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 so as to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend the threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that respondents No.4 to 10 are harassing petitioner No.1 physically and mentally so as to get her married against her wishes and she has left the home and is now residing with her maternal aunt, i.e. petitioner No.2. Learned counsel further submits that both the petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 26.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) raising the grievance as raised in

the writ petition, addressed to Superintendent of Police, Karnal, District Karnal, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation within a period of four weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order by passing appropriate speaking order.

In case, after the passing of the order, any consequent action needs to be taken in respect of the threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, the same be also taken by the authority.

Accordingly, the criminal writ petition is disposed of.
