Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.239 dated 16.06.2020, under Sections 307, 148 and 49 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' – for short) besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between young students who were playing football. The co-accused Daljit Singh and Ravisher Singh have been granted ad interim anticipatory bail.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and upon instructions from SI Tarsem Singh, states that the petitioner has been attributed a gunshot injury on the stomach of the injured Lovepreet Singh.

Heard.

The incident had taken place due to a sudden quarrel between youngsters who were playing football. However, the gun-shot injuries are attributed to the petitioner and the co-accused Nirmal Singh. The petitioner has been attributed a gun-shot injury on the stomach below the right abdomen of the injured. In these circumstances, I do not find it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petition stands dismissed.
