Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.288 dated 14.04.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 511, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Karnal.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 31.05.2021: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the location where the alleged fight took place is in the land purchased by the petitioner and her family members. The land was purchased vide sale deed dated 26.10.2020 and the incident took place on 13.04.2021. In April 2021, possession was to be handed over by the complainant party as the lease in their favour expired after harvesting the wheat crop. This is evident from the FIR got

registered by the petitioner and her family members against the complainant party, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-6. Thus, being a case of version and cross version, it can not be said that the petitioner party was the aggressor. The husband of the petitioner has also suffered injuries. The petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the investigation and got the weapon of assault (if any) recovered...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Chand and on the basis of reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Karnal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.05.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
