The present petition has been filed for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No.272 dated 21.05.2020 registered under Sections 34, 379-B and 394 IPC (Sections 307, 397, 201 and 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the reply filed by the learned State counsel in the Court today, he does not press for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the wife of the petitioner may need the assistance as her expected date of delivery is 24.06.2021 and, therefore, an appropriate authority be directed to take care of his wife in case any help is needed.

Learned State counsel very fairly submits that he will immediately request the Deputy Commissioner concerned to direct the officials of the Nari Niketan, which is situated in the area i.e. Adarsh Nagar, Bahadurgarh, where the wife of the petitioner is residing to visit her and to ensure that in case any help or assistance is needed by the wife of the petitioner, the same is extended to her by the said authority.

This satisfies the grievance of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
