1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of investigation in case FIR No.61 dated 02.09.2019 registered under Section 304-A IPC and Section 27, Arms Act at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran having been completed and the challan having been presented in the matter on 06.07.2021 in compliance of order dated 13.08.2020 in CRM-M No.22478 of 2020, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Since the respondents have concluded the investigation and thereafter taken-up action by way of filing challan on 06.07.2021 in case FIR No.61 dated 02.09.2019 registered under Section 304-A IPC and Section 27, Arms Act at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran in compliance of order dated 13.08.2020 in CRM-M No.22478 of 2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is warranted against the respondents.
4. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
