The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.76 dated 12.03.2020 under Section 379-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 ( Sections 392, 397, 506, 411, 34 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jhajjar.

The FIR was registered on the statement of one Krishan, who reported that he is an employee of Kuro Maruti at Bawal. On 12.03.2020 he came to attend his office on his motorcycle to Jhajjar Chota Silani Bypass. He parked the motorcycle at a tea shop. While he was waiting for a bus, one Maruti car make Celerio of white colour came and offered seat to get to Rewari. The complainant and two others boarded the car. Two persons were already sitting there. When they reached near Gijarod turn, they stopped the car by taking the excuse of urination. After returning one person covered the face of the complainant with a towel and started giving

him beatings. He snatched his phone, bag and purse. There were Rs.700/-

and an ATM in the purse, while the bag contained Rs.60,000/-. They also extracted the pin of the ATM from the complainant and after reaching Kosli at about 6:30 a.m they withdrew Rs.3000/- from the ATM in front of Court of Kosli. They were armed with revolver and threatened to kill the complainant if he disclosed this fact to anyone. The complainant was thrown out of the vehicle near Kosli flyover on Kanina road.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the complainant has given affidavit (P2) duly attested by Executive Magistrate to the effect that the petitioner was not involved in the present case and that he does not want to take any action against the petitioner. It is further argued that investigation in the case is complete and challan has already been filed. The petitioner had not been named in the FIR and his name surfaced during the disclosure statement of an accused in some other case. The petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2020.

It is further stated that co-accused Vikrant @ Toni has been granted bail by this Court, while another co-accused Dharmender has been granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case this petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
