Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellants are prepared to accept the proposal of enhancement of Rs.4,20,000/- towards full and final settlement of claim of the appellants in the present appeal. This enhancement shall be over and above the amount already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Panipat.

The appellants would be satisfied in case appeal is disposed of in terms of consensus arrived at between the parties.

Mr. Ram Avtar, Advocate for the Insurance Company undertakes to pay the enhanced amount of Rs.4,20,000/-.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.4,20,000/- in the name of the appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the

High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due date till final realization of the amount. The apportionment shall be made in the same manner as observed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. On receiving the cheque from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
