Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.34 dated 12.05.2021 under Sections 458, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 02.06.2021, which reads as under:

“Counsel for the petitioner herein prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, while contending that the petitioner herein entered the house of the complainant carrying iron rod in his hand and inflicted injuries with the same.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The State is directed to place a copy of the MLR on the record.

Adjourned to 10.06.2021.”

He further states that subsequently after hearing, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner on 17.06.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in

deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Baljit Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.06.2021 is made absolute.
