Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to argue the matter on merits to the effect that the petitioner has only been arraigned as an accused on the basis suspicion, with there being no eye witness to the death of the complainants' father, and that he has been in custody for about 3 years and 7 months. Learned State counsel submits that as per his instructions only one prosecution witness remains to be examined and therefore at this stage in any case the petitioner should not be admitted to bail.

In the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition at this stage.
