By way of this petition, the petitioner, who is presently lodged in District Jail, Faridkot, seeks the relief of emergency parole for a period of six weeks on the ground that his wife, who is pregnant, is expected to deliver their child during the period from 15.06.2021 to 30.06.2021.

Ms. Rashmi Attri, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has joined the proceedings on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.2, by way of his affidavit, along-with Annexure R/T-1, has also been received through *e-mail* and these documents have been placed on the record.

A bare reading of the afore-said affidavit shows that it has categorically been mentioned in para 2 therein that the proceedings in the case of the parole of the petitioner have already been initiated vide Annexure R/T-1. A perusal of Annexure R/T-1 reveals that respondent No.2 has forwarded the case of the parole of the petitioner to respondent No.3 for further necessary action.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take appropriate action in the afore-referred matter within some specific time-frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter in hand, the instant petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-District Magistrate, Ludhiana, to consider and take the decision in the matter pertaining to the parole of the petitioner, as duly forwarded to him vide Annexure R/T-1, in accordance with law/relevant Rules by 15.06.2021 positively.
