Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner in case FIR No.52 dated 14.04.2021 under Sections 323, 324 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC were added later on) registered at Police Station Goraya, Police District Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while reiterating the stand of petitioner further submits that as a matter of fact, dispute between the parties is basically of civil nature and it has been projected to be criminal one. He further urges that even otherwise alleged grievous injury on the person of injured Harbhajan Singh attributed to petitioner is not on the vital organ of the body. He further urges that it is a case of FIR version and cross-version, wherein petitioner-Tarlochan Singh had sustained as many as seven (07) injuries on his person, as is evident from his Medico-Legal Report (Annexure P-2). He further urges that it is yet to be decided during course of trial as to which party was the aggressor one.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub

Inspector Harjeet Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 02.06.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 02.06.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
