MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the official respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty from private respondent Nos.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that private respondent Nos.5 to 8 are not allowing him to enter in the land owned and possessed by him. He submits that in respect of the land in question, the finding by Civil Court has been returned in favour of the petitioner. He claims himself to be the owner of the land in question after demise of his father.

Considering the nature of the relief claimed and the availability of alternative remedy in law with the petitioner, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
