ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Petitioners pray for mandamus commanding the official respondents (respondents No.2 & 3) to protect their lives and liberty.

Petitioners Gurpreet Kaur and Nitesh Mehta claim themselves to be major. They purport to have been in a relationship for some time in the past. Though, they intended to marry each other but the move was resisted by the parents of petitioner no.1. But finally the petitioners alleged to have solemnized marriage on 28.05.2021, contrary to the wish of the private respondents, at Gurdwara Dashmesh Pita Patshahi Daswi, Village Singa Davi, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali. Their case is that despite their persistent efforts the private respondents are not ready to accept their relationship or reconcile with their marriage. And, instead the petitioners have been threatened with dire consequences and thus they apprehend danger to their lives. Faced with this situation, the petitioners had even

represented to respondent no.2 vide representation dated 28.5.2021 to take necessary measures, but to no avail.

In the wake of the above, and without commenting upon the veracity of the allegations set out in the petition as also the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.2), that, if any such representation, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be considered and dealt with expeditiously and in accordance with law.
