The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 01.05.2021, under Sections 15 and 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

2. The petitioner is alleged to have transported *Poppy-husk* brought from Jharkhand in a Canter make Bharat Benz, bearing Registration No. PB-11CJ 8054.

3. It, however, transpires that no recovery was ever effected directly from the petitioner. His complicity has transpired from the disclosure statement of the co-accused Paramjit Singh @ Bappa, who happens to be his maternal uncle. The petitioner is not reported to be involved in any other case

under the NDPS Act.

4. In the circumstances, the petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of Report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (Challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.
