Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0149, dated 30.04.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506, 377 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

By virtue of the order dated 04.06.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and got effected the recovery as well and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is neither ready to reconcile the matter and nor got

effected the complete recovery.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kiran Pal Kaur has endorsed the fact of joining investigation by the petitioner and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation and the police has recovered Rs.65,000/- from the petitioner in lieu of articles.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 04.06.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.

CRM No.23197 of 2021 is dismissed.
