ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The petitioners seek direction to respondent no.1 and 5 to register an FIR and thereafter take appropriate action on their complaint dated 20.05.2021.

Some facts are required to be noticed. The petitioners (Ranjit Singh and Gagandeep Kaur) claim that they are living in a live-in relationship. Petitioner no.2-Gagandeep Kaur got married with Manjit Singh-respondent no.10. He works in Gujarat. Petitioner no.2 claims that Manjit Singh was already married to Gaganpreet Kaur, however, petitioner no.2 started cohabiting with him. A daughter was born from the loins of Manjit Singh on 10.02.2014. Thereafter, she claims that she started residing with petitioner no.1 (Ranjit Singh). The father of petitioner no.1 filed a petition i.e CRWP-2881-2021 alleging that the mother of petitioner no.1 has been illegally kept in custody by the police. Subsequently, the petitioner no.1's mother was allegedly

released. Thereafter, petitioner no.2 filed CRWP-2921-2021 which was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to avail the alternative remedy. It is also not in dispute that CRWP-3070-2021 filed by Manjit Singh alleging that his daughter has been illegally detained by Ranjit Singh is pending in this Court for 02.09.2021, in which the petitioners herein are also a party.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Bench does not find it appropriate to issue any direction. The petitioners are relegated to the alternative remedy of filing a criminal complaint before the Magistrate.

Disposed of.

All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
