The petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking direction to the respondents to decide/adjudicate grievance dated 19.04.2021 (Annexure P3) in letter and spirit addressed against the arbitrary rejection of renewal of Arms Licence Application No. 13450351 without any cogent and specific reasons.

Notice of motion.

Ms Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice.

A perusal of the paper book shows that the order rejecting the application of the petitioner has already been passed. It is not even disputed that the necessary statutory appeal has not been preferred by the petitioner against the order passed by competent authority.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has not been provided with a copy of the rejection order passed by the authority, therefore, statutory appeal could not be filed by the petitioner; against the said order.

In response to this, counsel for the State has submitted that a copy of the order passed by the authority shall be provided to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date, he moves an application for the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to furnish a copy of the order passed against the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date, the petitioner makes an application for that purpose. Still further, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file statutory appeal against the said order. If there is any limitation prescribed by the statute for filing the appeal, the same is ordered to be condoned, in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
