The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 01.05.2021, registered under Sections 307, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 04.06.2021 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The operative part of the order dated 04.06.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was a case of version and cross-version which occurred due to sudden provocation between the parties and the incident has taken place in an open street.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even the petitioner has suffered a head injury at the instance of

the complainant party.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that it will be a matter of trial as to who was the aggressive party”.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Lakhbir Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 04.06.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
