This application is for placing on record copies of the electricity bill, registration certificate and insurance policy of the petitioner as Annexures P-3 to P-5 respectively.

Heard. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and Annexures P-3 to P-5 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 09.01.2020, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Sohna, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was falsely implicated in the FIR and had left his residence after his second marriage in the year 2013.

Heard.

The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.31 dated 27.01.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram as it is alleged that the petitioner had impersonated as Vedi s/o Fituri and sold his land. Vedi s/o Fituri had expired on 16.06.1968 and the FIR was lodged by his widow. The petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed person vide order dated 19.11.2015.

In view of the above, I do not find any good ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
