HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 26.07.2018 under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station GRP, District Ludhiana.

As per the allegations in the FIR, 3360 capsules of Spasmo Proxyvon(R) Plus were recovered from one Rajesh Kumar.

The name of the petitioner has surfaced in the disclosure statement suffered by co-accused Rajesh Kumar. From the petitioner 80 intoxicant tablets have been recovered. The recovery from the petitioner is less than the commercial quantity. Petitioner is in custody since January, 2020.

In view of the above and the fact that the trial is unlikely to conclude in near future more so in the wake of outbreak of

pandemic COVID, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner-Dimple Kumar @ Lalli is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
