The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and personal liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

Petitioner was married to respondent No.5 on 11.04.2004. Two sons namely Nikhil Khanna and Ankit Khanna took birth out of this wedlock. Owing to the conduct of respondent No.5, petitioner along with his children started living in another house since February, 2017. Respondent No.5 is living in the original house of the petitioner. Petitioner is being harassed with the help of respondent No.4. Petitioner has given details of complaints filed by respondent No.5 in para no.6 of the petition.

Even the petitioner has orally argued that during summer

vacations, respondent No.3 has acted indifferently so as to give undue advantage by compelling the petitioner to part with property.

Petitioner has also moved a representation to respondent No.2 on 24.05.2021 and the same has not been decided so far.

At this stage, petitioner would be satisfied in case his representation dated 24.05.2021 is decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents, as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 24.05.2021 of the petitioner in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
