Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 20.05.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 452, 506 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sector 13-17 Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were unarmed and the alleged altercation took place as the complainant had been stalking co-accused Sheetal. Sheetal had also received several injuries in the occurrence.

This Court, by the order dated 03.06.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has filed reply of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime Against Women, Panipat. He, upon instructions, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 03.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
