The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to quash the impugned notice dated 30.11.2020 (Annexure P-7) vide which the respondents had stated that the 'NOC' will be issued later without providing any reasons for the delay in issuance of 'NOC' to the petitioner with further prayer that provisional pension to the petitioner be granted and delayed

payment of pension be made alongwith interest @ 18% per annum alongwith other benefits, for which, legal notice dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-11) has also been served by the petitioner.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the legal notice dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-11) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
