Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 22.05.2021 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 01.07.2021: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has received a sum of Rs.5.00 lacs, which he is ready to return to the complainant. Counsel for

the petitioner has placed on record a Demand Draft of Rs.5.00 lacs dated 22.06.2021 favouring Buta Singh i.e. the victim...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation and he has also handed over the Demand Draft of Rs.5.00 lacs to the victim.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Beant Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.07.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
