The present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointing a Warrant Officer to locate and recover the detainee/wife of the present petitioner.

Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala is stated to be unwell and in his place Shri Brij Mohan, DSP, Barnala has made compliance of the last order dated 02.06.2021 and produced the detainee, namely, Amandeep Kaur through video conferencing.

This Court has put a query to the alleged detainee and has found that she is free from any undue influence and would voluntarily state that she married with the petitioner-Balwant Singh according to her own wishes and she has no grudge against the petitioner. She further made it clear that

presently she is residing with her parents, i.e., private respondents out of her own sweet will and would not join the company of the petitioner. She also made it clear that she will not initiate any legal action against her husband regarding the said marriage having taken place on 21.07.2020 at Gurdwara Sahib Nirmal Asthan, Chungan Road, Dharmkot, District Moga.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous and the same is disposed of, accordingly.
