The petitioner herein seeks the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case pertaining to the FIR bearing No.22 dated 14.03.2020 registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC.

Learned State counsel has forwarded the status report filed on behalf of the respondent-State by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub-Division Banga, SBS Nagar, to this Court through email and the same is taken on record. She, on the instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar, Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 01.07.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner had joined in the investigation of the case and his custodial interrogation is not required and even the Challan has also been

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presented before the competent Court and that the petitioner has not been declared a proclaimed person in this case nor he is involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-discussed submission of learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner vide the said order dated 01.07.2021, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
