JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.76 dated 23.05.2018 under Sections 304 B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would submit that the instant FIR has been registered at the behest of Mr. Vijay Kumar who is father of the deceased who committed suicide leaving behind her a suicide note in which there is no mention that the petitioner herein was instrumental in any manner whatsoever in her taking her life. It is argued that the suicide note was sent to the FSL for examination and found that the handwriting on the suicide note was that of the deceased. Learned counsel would submit that even taking into account the contents of the suicide note, petitioner ought to be allowed regular bail. It is also submitted that out of 26 witnesses cited, material witnesses have been examined and,

therefore, the question of influencing the complainant by the petitioner would not arise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, would oppose the bail application referring to the seriousness of the allegations.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

In view of the fact that the material witnesses stand examined and there remains no chances for the petitioner to hamper the trial in any manner, without commenting the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
