The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 19.08.2019 registered
under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur.

During the pendency of the present petition, a compromise was
arrived at between the petitioners and the complainant as per which the
petitioners were to return to the complainant an amount of Rs.15 lakhs in
instalments. It is not disputed that till date the petitioners have lived up to
the compromise and returned to the complainant an amount of Rs.9 lakhs
and have also joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the
interim orders of this Court dated 28.07.2020 and 06.10.2020 granting ad-
interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners are made absolute. However, it

is clarified that in case the petitioners do not pay to the complainant the entire agreed amount in terms of the afore-referred compromise, the State/complainant shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application before this Court seeking cancellation of the petitioners' anticipatory bail.
