Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153 dated 16.11.2011, under Sections 365, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 54, 59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Gharaun, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel contends that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved with the intervention of the respectables and the complainant executed an affidavit dated 25.10.2019 in this regard in favour of the petitioner and other accused persons. He submits that on the basis of the said compromise, a petition, i.e., CRM-M-49779 of 2019 for quashing the subject FIR is pending in this court. It is pointed out that now the local police is raiding the house of the petitioner to arrest him.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this court does not find any reason to interfere in the matter. The petitioner has approached

this court after a long delay as the FIR is of the year 2011. No ground is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
