The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Akashdeep Garg, stated to be aged 18 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.32 dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-2), with reference to DDR No.17 dated 06.02.2021 for offence under Section 336, 337 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act in FIR No.17 dated 05.02.2021, under Section 307 IPC, at Police Station Bhikhi (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the present petition has become infructuous as during pendency of the same, the petitioner has since been arrested.
