Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of impugned order dated 13.12.2010 whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed person by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala in FIR No.385 dated 22.08.2009 under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he is ready to appear before the Court concerned and this Court may consider granting him protection in the meantime.

The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the Court concerned and apply for the necessary relief before that Court.

In case, the petitioner appear before the Court within seven

days from today then he would have a protection of seven days from being arrested from the date of his appearance. The Court would take into consideration the grievances made by the petitioner on the basis of the merits of the case, in accordance with law.

The petition is disposed of.

If the petitioner does not appear before the said Court within seven days, the benefit of this order will automatically go.
