Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 13.07.2020 for the offences under Sections 376 and 506 IPC (Sections 376-D and 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Women Police Station, Sonapat District Sonapat.

In compliance of order dated 15.06.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the OPD tickets of AIIMS, New Delhi of the son of the petitioner. As per OPD Card, son of the petitioner has been given an appointment in the AIIMS, New Delhi for 09.07.2021. He further submits that since the OPD has started functioning, there is every likelihood that the son of the petitioner shall be operated upon at AIIMS, New Delhi shortly after his visit to the doctor on 09.07.2021. It has therefore been prayed that the petitioner be extended the concession of interim bail so that she can accompany her minor son to AIIMS, New Delhi and be with him during the course of his treatment there.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and with no objection from the State counsel, present petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of seven weeks i.e. from 02.07.2021 to 19.08.2021 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender on 20.08.2021 before the jail authorities concerned.
