Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.177 dated 02.12.2020 under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had caused a gandasi blow on the head of the injured Jagir Singh and another blow from the reverse side of gandasi on the head of Jaswinder. He, however, contends that the injured have fully recovered from the injuries. The matter has been compromised. A copy of the compromise is annexed as Annexure P-2. The petitioner is in custody for over 06 months.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 05 months and 28 days as on 23.07.2021.

He upon instructions states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for 06 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
